

‘Parivartan’ – The Slum Education Programme Activity on 28th July, 2013

The slums of Vasundhara, Sector – 1, Ghaziabad resounded on Sunday 28th July, 2013 with the resolution sung by the slum children as ‘Hum honge kaamyab ek din’. The PGDM student volunteers of ITS, Ghaziabad namely Shalabh Bhardwaj, Vinod Kumar, Avinash Gupta, Ravi Prasad, Shayan Das Gupta and Shubhojit reached the venue around 4 p. m. and gave a routine call to the slum children. As soon as they assembled at the fixed spot, their class under the shades of trees started.

Starting with the English alphabets the children were also briefed about the pictures in series like - when they repeated X for X-ray, they were told what an X-ray is, which they really did not know. Later one poem in English and one in Hindi were recited, repeated and explained. Finally they practiced the song in chorus – ‘Hum honge kaamyab ek din’.

The class for the day ended with the distribution of chips, chocolates and biscuits among the slum children. The student volunteers were guided and accompanied by the faculty coordinator Prof. Gopal Krishna Dwivedi. Besides, SEP in Sahibabad area also continued as usual and around 35 slum children learnt important lessons as per schedule. This class was conducted by PGDM senior batch students Meraj Akhtar, Abhishek Kumar Raj and the co-volunteers.
